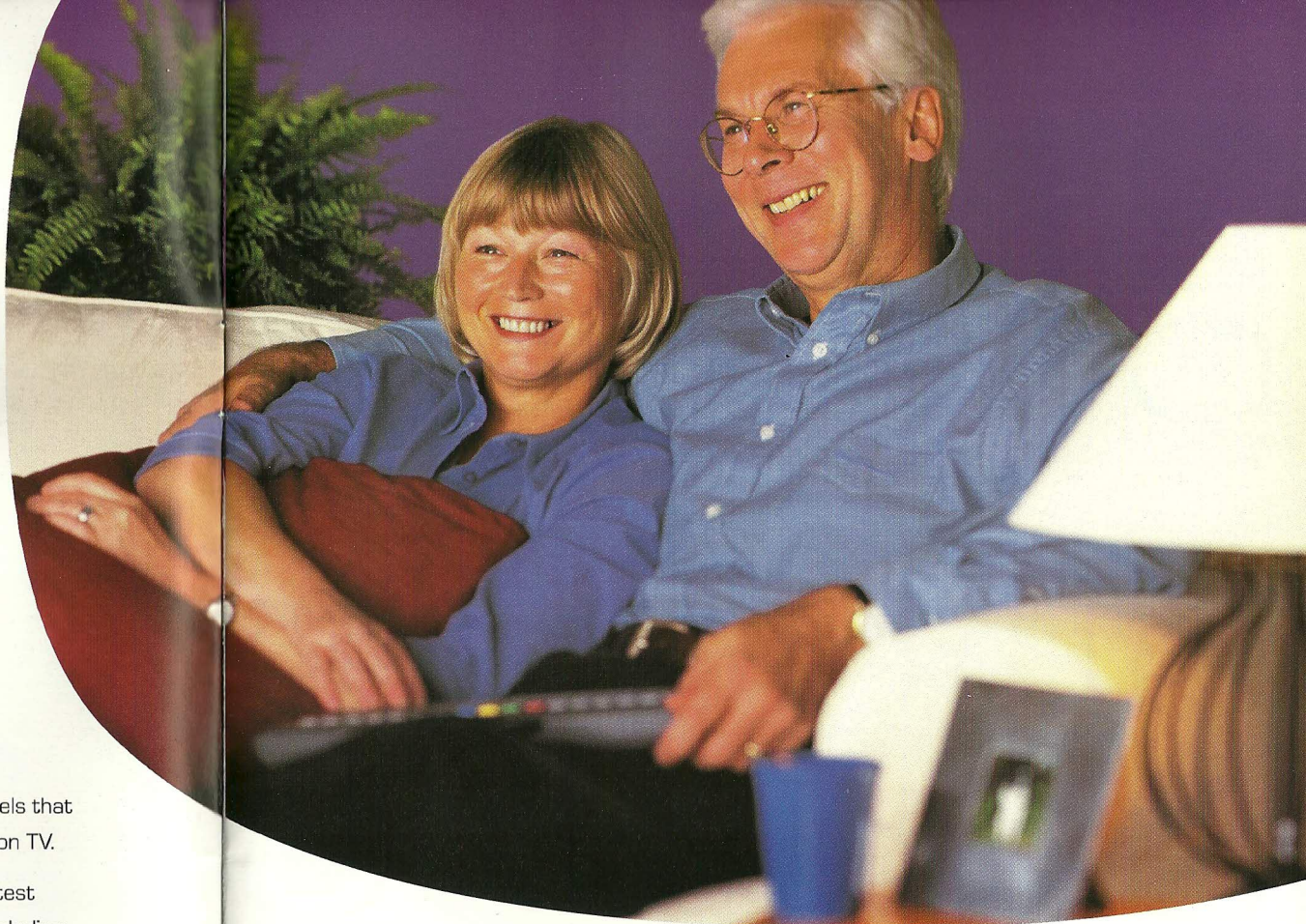

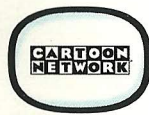

The affordable way to use the Internet

ONnet makes accessing the Internet affordable. The ONnet box is the size of a paperback book and plugs into your TV and ONdigital box. Then just connect it to a phone line, and use the remote keyboard to explore the Internet.

You don't need to buy a new PC. Your ONnet box and remote keyboard are free while you subscribe to ONdigital and access to ONnet is only £5 per month.

For BT customers calls cost 2p per minute peak and 1p per minute off-peak and at weekends.

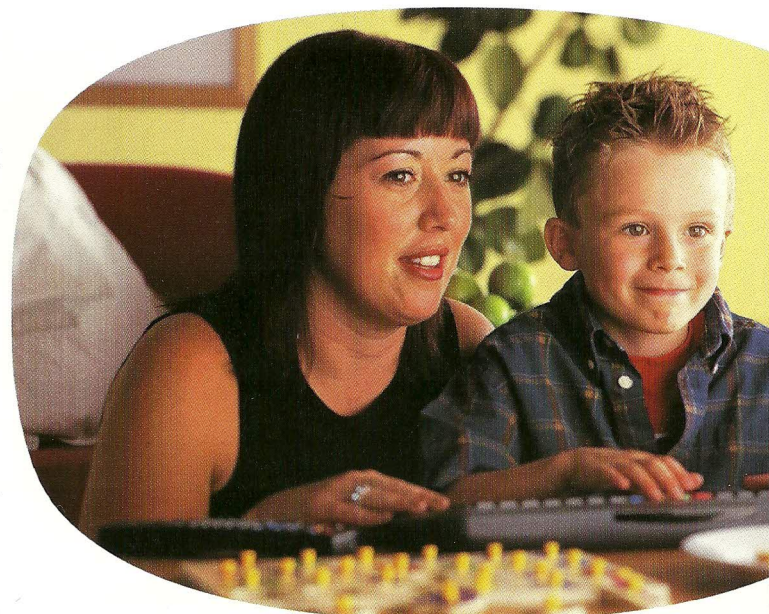

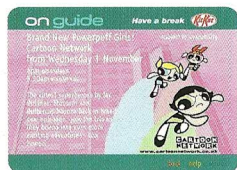

There are two main ways to get ONdigital – with a free ONdigital box or through an Integrated Digital Television (idTV).

Or if you prefer, you can choose one of our Prepaid options – these are detailed in separate leaflets.

How to get ONdigital

Free ONdigital box

All you need to receive ONdigital is an ONdigital box that plugs in to your TV.

The box is free to all ONdigital subscribers while they subscribe. It comes with clear instructions, so it's simple to set up (usually in less than 20 minutes). One of the handy things about ONdigital is that you can use the box in any room that has an aerial socket.

Once you have your free ONdigital box you then simply pay a monthly subscription depending on your choice of channels and additional services. To find out more, turn to page 11.

You can also choose to take ONnet – Internet access through your TV for just £5 extra per month (plus call charges). Your ONnet box sits neatly on top of your ONdigital box and is free while you subscribe.



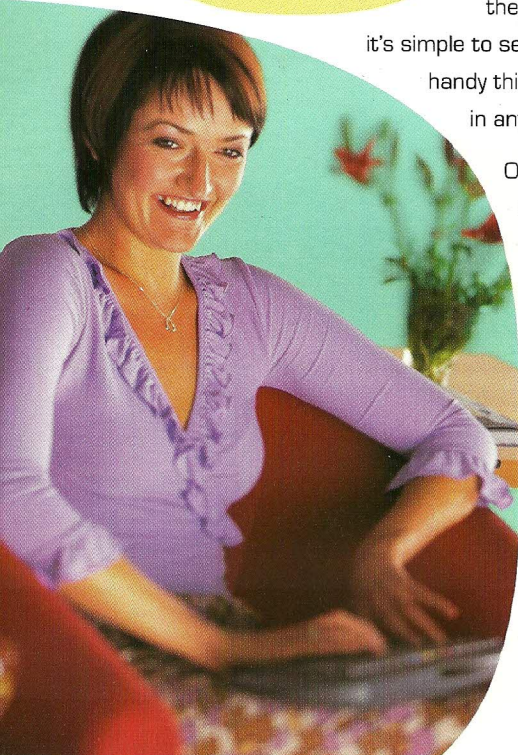
idTV

idTVs come with any six available Primary channels for 12 months at no extra cost.

idTVs come with ONdigital technology built in – so there's no need for a dish, cable or even an ONdigital box. This makes ONdigital the natural choice for idTV owners, plus idTVs now come with your choice of six available ONdigital Primary channels for the first 12 months at no extra cost. You can also choose to take ONnet – Internet access through your TV.

To receive ONdigital all you need is a Smartcard which slots into your idTV. (Some televisions will also require a credit card-sized CAM module, supplied free of charge.) You will be sent this Smartcard together with your CAM, if necessary, when you buy your idTV.

If you choose to take all available ONdigital Primary channels or our Premium channels, then you simply call ONdigital and pay a monthly subscription. To find out more, turn to page 13.



How much will it cost?

To allow you more freedom of choice, there are two ways to receive ONdigital, a free ONdigital box or an idTV. Simply choose the option which suits you best.

Free ONdigital box pricing

Free ONdigital box for as long as you subscribe to ONdigital.



Introductory Offer – For the first three months you can receive all of our available Primary channels for just £9.99 a month, so you can get to know them before you make your choice.

Option 1 – £13.00 a month

All available Primary channels to add to your free-to-view channels, plus 2000/2001 UEFA Champions League football.

Option 2 – £9.99 a month

Your pick of six available Primary channels to add to your free-to-view channels, plus 2000/2001 UEFA Champions League football.

Option 3 – £6.99 a month

Simply choose your favourite Primary channel. This option doesn't include UEFA Champions League.

ONnet pricing

The ONnet box and keyboard are free while you subscribe to ONdigital and access to ONnet costs just £5 per month. Telephone charges are not included, however, if you are a BT customer calls cost just 2p per minute peak and 1p per minute off-peak and at weekends.

How to subscribe – for free ONdigital box customers

1. Visit your nearest ONdigital retailer and ask to sign up to ONdigital.
2. Choose your channels from the selection on pages 3-4.
3. Select ONnet if you would like Internet access through your TV.
4. Sign the Customer Agreement Form and pick up your free ONdigital box (and free ONnet box if you have selected ONnet).

Customers in limited coverage areas may only be able to receive certain ONdigital channels and will therefore be offered a selection of Primary and Premium channels at a special price. Your retailer will let you know if this applies to you, please ask for further details.

idTV pricing

idTVs come with six available ONdigital Primary channels for 12 months.



If you sign up to ONdigital when buying an idTV, your idTV will come with your choice of any six available ONdigital Primary channels for the first 12 months. For just £3 per month you can also receive ALL available ONdigital Primary channels for the first 12 months. And you can also add any of our popular Premium channels for an extra charge. Simply contact ONdigital for further details.

ONnet pricing

How to buy – for idTV customers

4. Call ONdigital if you wish to add extra channels.
